## LISTS OF APPROVED TREES AND SHRUBS FOR THE WEBSTER ARBORETUM AND SOME BACKGROUND DATA

Attached are lists of trees and shrubs that are needed in the Webster Arboretum. All trees are \$425 apiece. Trees are approximately 2 inches in diameter at one foot above the ground. The price of shrubs is \$150. Shrubs are in 3 to 5 gallon containers, or balled and burlapped. Availability of particular trees or shrubs is not guaranteed. Planting locations in the Arboretum are approximate.

Price includes purchase, planting, appropriate care (feeding, pruning, etc.) and a 4 inch by 6 inch botanical marker that will list the tree or shrub's Latin name, common name and dedication (if applicable). All stock is guaranteed for three years. Size and species of stock may vary because of market conditions. Information about specific trees or shrubs can be found at the public library.

If you desire to contribute to the Arboretum, but are unsure about the type of contribution to make, there is an alternative to a planting: The Webster Arboretum Association, a not-for-profit charitable corporation supporting the Arboretum. All the funds raised go to the Arboretum and their entire staff is comprised of volunteers. They have memberships available at several levels, and they will direct donations toward plantings, and toward the highest areas of need in the Arboretum. 
